New Prague has seven walking and biking trails in several sections of the city covering 30-plus miles dating back to the late-1990s or newer for residents and visitors to the community to utilize.

A map of the community's walking and biking trails is on the city's website – www.co.new-prague.mn.us – for people to visit to check out. The city has a maintenance schedule for its trails.

New Prague's Northside Loop covers 3.1 miles. It runs along the north side of Highway 13-19/West Main Street east to County Road 37 up to Northeast Seventh Street and onto Northwest Seventh Street before looping south to West Main Street via Northwest Fourth Avenue.

New Prague Homefield Loop covers 3.1 miles. It starts on the west side of Heritage Park heading west and north to Northeast Heritage Trail with a loop along to Northeast Independence Street and Northeast Freedom Avenue.

The trail heads north along North Columbus Avenue and west to Northwest 12th Street. It loops north along the west side of the high school property before looping back toward Northwest 12th Street.

On the west side of the city, New Prague's Raven Stream Trail covers one mile and loops around the elementary school using Northwest First Street, Northwest 11th Street, Northwest Grant Avenue and Northwest Kennedy Avenue.

New Prague's 1.5-mile span Foundry Hill Loop covers a span of West Main Street, from Northwest 11th Street to Northwest Sixth Avenue. It runs north to Northwest Second Street up the park to Northwest Fourth Street.

New Prague's Southside Loop covers 1.53 miles and is approximately a square running from Highway 21/Southwest Fourth Avenue to Southeast First Avenue, where it turns north to West Main Street and back to Highway 21.

The Tikalsky Loop is a 2.64-mile trail east of the golf course with two loops connected by a trail along the east side of Southeast 10th Avenue. The northern loop runs Southeast Fifth Street to Southeast Chalupsky Avenue and then turns to East Main Street, eventually returning to Southeast 10th Avenue. The southern loop starts along Southeast Tikalsky Avenue from Southeast 10th Avenue. It loops around to Southeast Olivia Street and follows Le Sueur County Road 29 to Southeast 10th Avenue.

New Prague's Praha Village Loop is bordered by Southeast 10th Avenue on the west side, Southeast Ninth Street on the south side, Southeast Chalupsky Avenue on the east side and East Main Street on the north side.

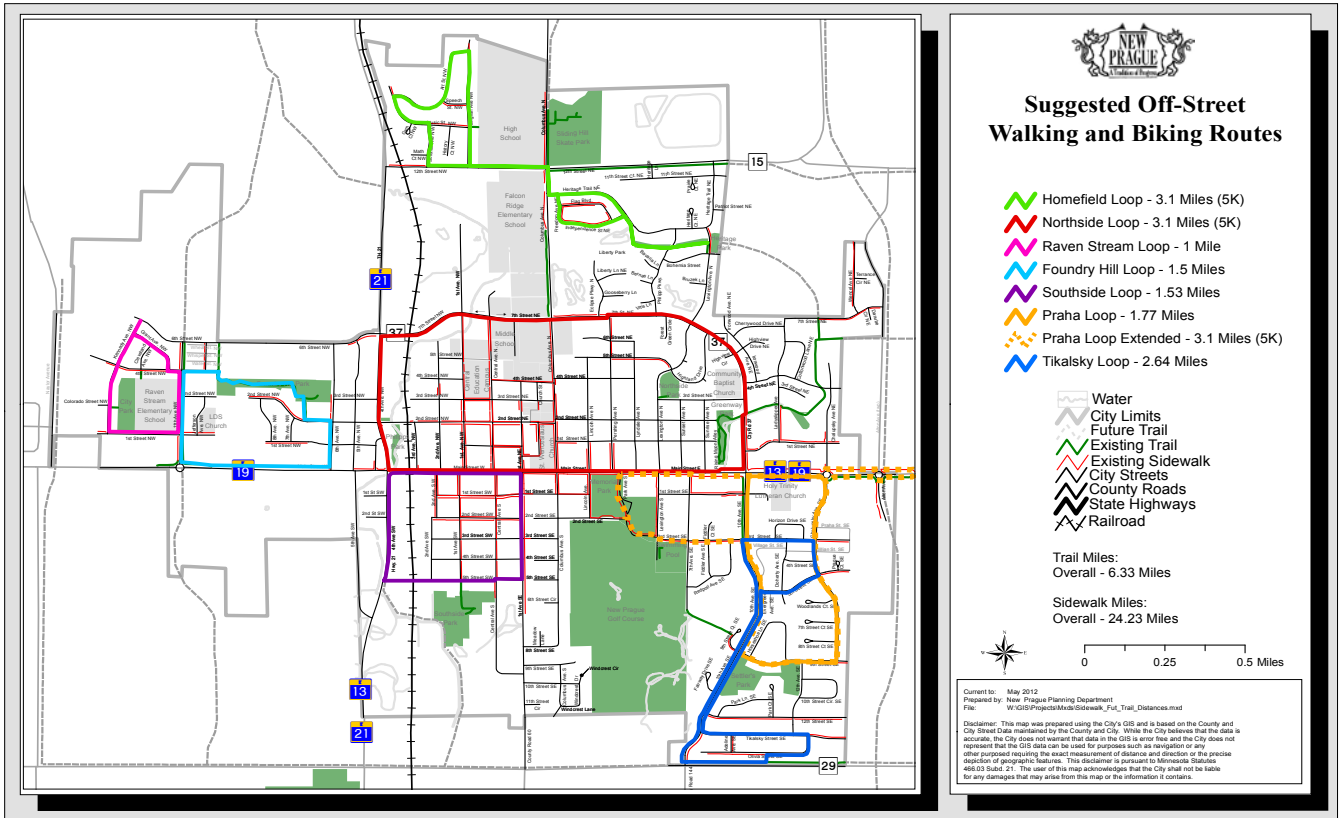

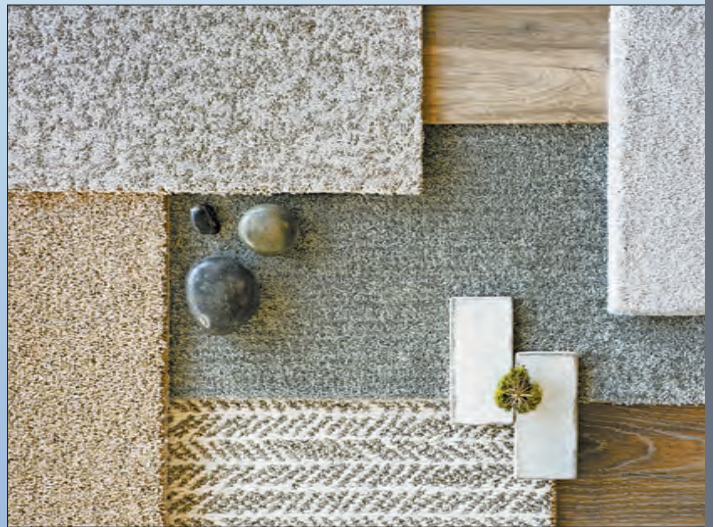

Nestled among some of the richest farmland in the state, Montgomery's proximity to larger communities makes it an ideal place to visit, work or call home.

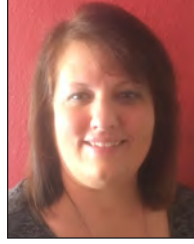
Montgomery's central business district, also listed on the National Register of Historic Places, offers a glimpse of our rural past through the presence of historic buildings and quiet small town charm.

The city has 6.96 miles of alleyways that are improved using a minimum of gravel pavement. New Prague also has 7.59 miles of trails. Just over .42 of a mile has been added since 2013. There are 26.26 miles of sidewalks in New Prague, with just over 1.9 miles of sidewalk added since 2013.

Lonsdale FUN FACTS

Lonsdale has one water tower. It is 100 feet tall and holds 300,000 gallons of water. A typical well pumping cycle takes about 1.5 hours to fill the tower. The city of Lonsdale has two wells that pull water from the Mt. Simon aquifer. The wells run seven or eight times per day. Residents and businesses use about 280,000 gallons of water per day.

New Prague FUN FACTS

New Prague utilities has two water towers, one on the east side of the city and the other on the west side of town. Both towers are 160 feet tall from the ground level to the top of the bowl section of the tank. Both tanks hold 500,000 gallons of water supplying water to the distribution system for customers and fire protection.

In the event scheduled maintenance has to be done on a water tower, the tower has to be drained, maintenance performed, and tower refilled. The refilling process may take up to 36 hours to complete. The aquifers the city draws water from are the Tunnel City-Mt. Simon and the Tunnel City-Eau-Claire aquifers.

Lonsdale FUN FACTS

The city of Lonsdale's snow relocation fleet consists of:

Three single-axle dump trucks with front plows, wings, and salt/sand spreaders, one payloader with front plow and wing, snowblower that hooks up to the payloader for snow removal on Main Street, one utility tractor with a front mounted snowblower and rear blade and one cabbed mower with blower, broom, and blade attachments.

If all that's not enough, Lonsdale also utilizes one UTV with a V-Plow and salt spreader, a skid loader with snow bucket and one Olympia ice resurfacer.

Here's how it works:

To have the entire city plowed consists of plowing streets, trails, sidewalks, and parking lots. Also included is ice rink maintenance and ice resurfacing, hauling snow in the business district, and spreading salt/sand on streets.

An average snowfall would take 70 to 100 total manpower hours for a crew of seven to complete the work. If it is only required to spread salt/sand, it takes a total of six hours for a crew of two. It should also be noted that winter storms are hardly ever similar and can very easily exceed the 100-hour mark for the crew of seven.
